Create a memento of Hakodate using a Japanese calligraphy brush pen.

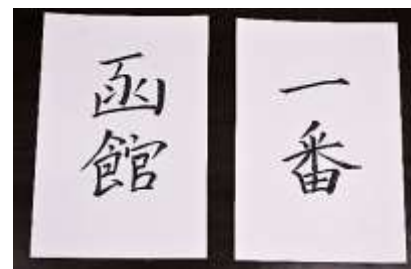
Visit the Hakodate Museum of Art, just across from Goryokaku Tower.
