The Hakodate Museum of Art, was opened next to Goryokaku Park in September 1986 with the goal of contributing to cultural development in the Donan, southern Hokkaido region. Themed on the features of the region, including artwork from the Donan, calligraphy, oriental art, and contemporary art concerning letters and symbols, the museum collects, preserves, exhibits and researches excellent works of art. At the same time, the museum actively promotes a variety of educational projects to familiarize the public with art in cooperation with the local communities.

## Museum Collection

In the permanent exhibit room and the Otei Memorial Room, works from the museum's collection are on display. They are changed three or four times a year, and the museum introduces artwork from the Donan region, calligraphy, oriental art, and contemporary art concerning letters and symbols. Some of the sculptures in the hall, including Bourdell, may be touched directly, and there are explanations in braille and large letters as well.

## Special Exhibitions

In the special exhibition room, exhibitions introducing diverse areas of Japanese and world wide artwork are organized.



**KAKIZAKI HAKYO**  
*Falcon* 1815

Sharp-eyed hawk. Ezo-nishiki silk with cloud and dragon pattern, imported from China. Both were the special products of the Matsumae Clan in the Ezo area (currently Hokkaido) during the Edo period. Filled with feelings toward his clan, this is one of the masterpieces of Hakyō, the painter of "Ishuretsuzo" which depicts 12 Ainu chieftains, and who worked as the chief retainer of the Matsumae Clan.

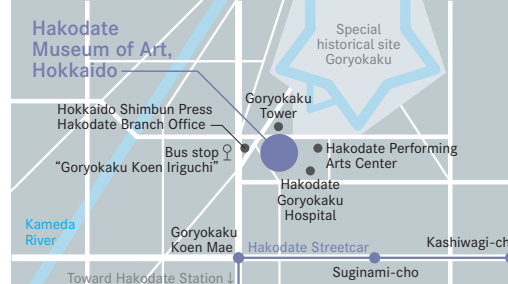

### ADDRESS

### ACCESS

Hakodate Bus: Get off at "Goryokaku Koen Iriguchi", "Geijutu Hall Mae", "Goryokaku Byoin Mae", or "Goryokaku". The museum is a 3 to 10 minutes walk from the bus stop.  
 Streetcar: Get off at "Goryokaku Koen Mae". The museum is 7 minutes walk from the car stop.  
 Taxi: About 10 minutes from JR Hakodate Station, 20 minutes from Hakodate Airport.

### HOURS

The museum is open daily from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. There is no admittance after 4:30 p.m.  
 Closed: Mondays (If Monday is a holiday, the museum will open and the following Tuesday will be closed), Dec. 29 to Jan. 3, may be closed temporarily for other exhibits.
