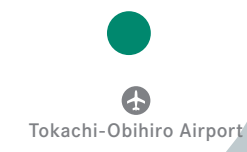
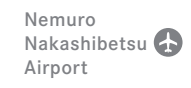

The Hokkaido Obihiro Museum of Art was opened as the 5th annex of the Hokkaido Museum of Modern Art in September 1991, in the corner of Midorigaoka Park near the center of Obihiro. Since then, the museum has systematically collected works with both regional and international themes from a long-term perspective and also hosts a variety of exhibitions and educational projects. The museum aims to further improve as a stage of lifelong learning that helps people build rich sensibilities through interacting with a variety of artwork.

Museum Collection

The museum policy is to collect modern and contemporary art centered on the works of artists representing the Doto region as well as Print-Art above all Japanese and foreign prints and posters, along with Western landscape or genre paintings, mainly by Barbizon painters. These collections are featured in themed exhibitions in the Collection Gallery, held several times a year, and in special collection exhibitions in the Main Exhibition Room.

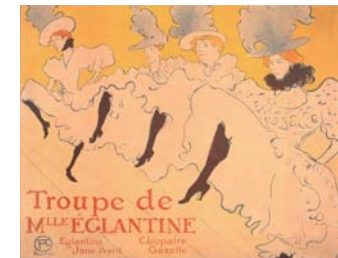
Special Exhibitions

ACCESS

Bus: Take the Takushoku Bus 21-24 South Commercial High School Line or 25 Obihiro-no-Mori Line at Obihiro Bus Terminal Platform 2. After about 16 minutes, get off at Midorigaoka Roku-chome/Bijutsukan Iriguchi. 4 minutes on foot.

Taxi: About 10 minutes from JR Obihiro Station.

Parking: Midorigaoka Park Parking Lot (free).

HOURS

The museum is open daily from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. There is no admittance after 4:30 p.m.

Closed: Mondays (If Monday is a holiday, the museum will open and the following Tuesday will be closed), Dec. 29 to Jan. 3, may be closed temporarily for other exhibits.
