Iwamizawa Shrine

The Iwamizawa-Shrine was built in Meiji era. About 40,000 people visit here every year. Over 50 people come daily. Iwamizawa Shrine has 2 guardiandogs. The Iwamizawa enshrine 2 Japanese Gots, named Amaterasookami and Oonamuchinokami.
